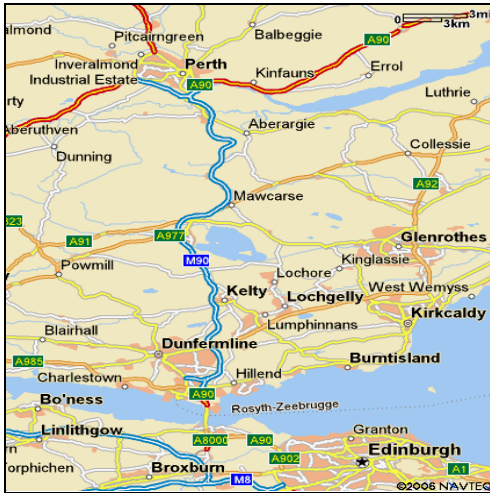


## PERTH, SCOTLAND
